Optional Tours

Morning: Bondi Beach

This morning's panoramic optional tour of Sydney starts at world famous Bondi Beach and historic and fashionable Paddington with its unique terrace houses. Continuing to Mrs. Macquarie's Chair and the Royal Botanic Gardens which offer extraordinary views of celebrated Sydney Harbour, the Harbour Bridge and the striking Sydney Opera House, named a UNESCO World Heritage Site.

Afternoon: Whale Watching Cruise

Sydney Whale Watching Cruise with lunch. Embark on a whale watching adventure aboard an air-conditioned catamaran. Sail by the Sydney Harbour Bridge and Sydney Opera House on your way to Sydney Heads. During the cruise enjoy a buffet style lunch. In the open water, there is a chance to view southern right, humpback, minke and orca whales. Afterward, return back to Sydney.

Morning : Optional Tour

Featherdale Wildlife Park & River Cruise

Participate in the optional day excursion to Featherdale Wildlife Park with river cruise and lunch. Featherdale is home to over 300 species of Australia's diverse wildlife. Admire the koalas, feed the kangaroos, view the fairy penguins, and see the colorful parrots, cockatoos, and lorikeets. Cruise along the Parramatta River with scenic views of the Sydney Skyline before lunch at the Rocks.



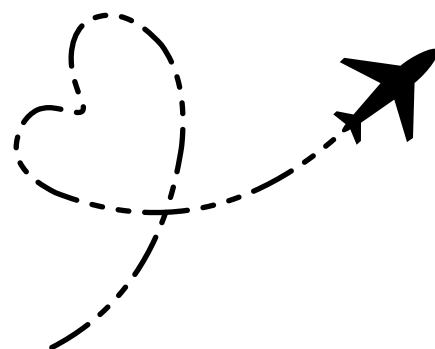

Morning : Airport Transfer

Flight to Cairns. Transfer to the airport in Sydney, for your flight to Cairns, the tourist capital of tropical North Queensland and gateway to the Great Barrier Reef. Spend the rest of the evening at leisure.

Green Island Excursion

Travel to beautiful Green Island, a coral cay located in the Great Barrier Reef (rising water temperatures and cyclones have resulted in bleaching of the coral reefs. Viewing has been significantly affected due to the slow recovery rates of the coral and the ecosystem. Choose to snorkel, view the coral gardens and marine life on a glass bottom boat, or simply relax on the white sandy beach admiring the view. This is truly a once-in-a-lifetime experience.

Morning:

Hartley's Wildlife Tour with Lunch

Depart Cairns and head north to explore an eco-park and working crocodile farm. Learn about Australia's incredible wildlife and discover the park's five different ecological zones. Walk along pathways and boardwalks to view the various native fauna and attend live shows and feedings to get acquainted with Australia's wildlife. After lunch, return to Cairns.

Afternoon:

Skyrail Experience with Dinner

Ride the Kuranda Skyrail that takes you on an amazing gondola experience over the oldest tropical rainforest in the world. Along the way, stop for a ranger guided boardwalk tour and visit the Rainforest Interpretation Centre, lookouts, and historical displays. Arrive at the historic village of Kuranda, nestled high up the tropical mountains. Spend time at leisure to explore the village and learn about Aboriginal culture. On the descent, marvel at the magnificent views of Barron Falls and Barron Gorge National Park. Conclude your tour with an authentic Australian dinner.

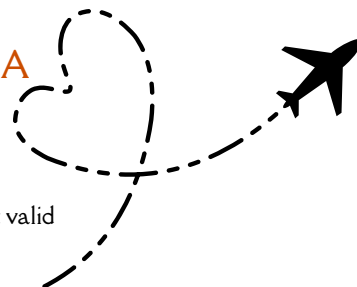

Walk through the Koala sanctuary where you may have the opportunity to take a photo. Later enter the enclosure of kangaroos to hand feed them. Keep your eyes open for wombats, Tasmanian devils, emus, penguins, and dingoes as you explore the rest of the park. Afterward, hop on a ferry to Circular Quay taking in the stunning views of Sydney Harbour. On arrival, walk to the Rocks, a historic neighborhood for lunch and free time. Take a river cruise down the Parramatta River with scenic views of the Sydney Skyline before lunch at the Rocks.

CANCELLATION POLICY

- 300 days or more, prior to scheduled group arrival date, no PENALTY will be assessed.
